## TOOLS:

#Jewelers' Pliers: smooth flat nose pliers, chain nose, & side cutter pliers or "snips" for advanced students: pliers that are flat on one side & half-round on the other side #Set of Diamond Needle Files (5 pc set @ Harbor Freight)
\*Jewelers' saw & blades

## SUPPLIES:

\*\*Wire 1/8 inch x 22 gauge & 22 gauge sheet 2x3 inches both sterling silver
\*\*Stainless steel dressmaker pins (1 and 1/8 inch or 1 and 1/4 inch length)

They usually have a ball on the end, most fabric stores carry them;

Be sure to read the label - must be stainless steel,

solder will stick to nickel plated pins. (I will have these)
\*Fire brick, flux & solder

## OTHER SUPPLIES:

#Sharp pencil or mechanical pencil #Small plastic container (or sandwich-size zip loc bag) to keep your small pieces of wire & stones during construction.
