Name of class: Hollow Form Inlaid Ring Class

Skill Level: Intermediate

Prerequisites: Silver soldering

Type of workshop: Metalsmithing & lapidary

Description: This is a class where you'll learn the secrets of inlaying on a small scale. You'll create delicate intarsias and intricate patterns to create a one-of-a-kind ring.

Length: 3 Days

Students will learn: Creating a hollow form ring to inlay stones into, make small intarsias to create intricate designs in stone and how to make those small 'dots' in your piece.
