Dear students,

In this class I will teach you how to get the most from cutting your opal rough. I have Australian Opal that we will be cutting.

If you have your own opal that you wish to cut, please bring it.

If you have never cut opal before, I would like you to cut a piece of Australian first - if you have Mexican opal or Ethiopian opal you want to cut, I will help you after you cut your first Australian opal.

The rough I have available is fairly small so please consider investing in an optivisor (a wearable magnifier), so you can see what you are doing <u>while</u> you are in the process of cutting.

You must have taken the beginning cabbing class to take this class. Also, I highly recommend taking Bill Mattis' Opal Class.

You will need to bring:

1.) apron

2.) towel

3.) fine point sharpie

4.) small crazy glue

5.) optivisor (or some similar magnification device) Artbeads.com &

Amazon.com have them as well as other lapidary supply sites/catalogs & eBay.

6.) Any opals/rough you might want to bring to cut or talk about.

7.) Fee for supplies: \$15.00
