Supply List for Richard Salley Workshop - Heirloom Silver Locket Summer 2018

Materials fee, payable to the instructor, approximately \$25.

Students will need to bring two half-heart shaped stones (as in the example) which measure about $20mm \times 35mm$. If they don't want to make a heart shape, then two stones similar in size that can fit together (each stone not larger than $20mm \times 35mm$).



Basic jewelry making tools will be needed, including round nose, chain nose and flat nose pliers wire cutters hand files or needle files wire cutters rawhide or nylon mallet metal shears jeweler's saw and blades (#3/0 or #2/0) bench pin, bench block or anvil, scribe or fine point Sharpie marker bezel pusher, bezel rocker or burnisher safety glasses

OPTIONAL:

miter vise/jig optivisors or other magnifying aide photo or copy of a photo for the inside of the locket
