

Boro Chain-making - Guest Instructor Jeri Warhaftig

This workshop is for those with some glass flameworking experience.

This is a one-day workshop, March 10, 2025. We will start at 9AM. **Please arrive no later than 8:45AM so that we may start on time.** The class will be held at the Tuscarora Lapidary Society's Education Center at 24 Upland Road, Brookhaven, PA 19015.

If you have glass beadmaking tools such as tungsten tweezers and patterned mashers such as leaf, spiral, or herringbone, please bring them. Bring your own suitable eye protection, which should be didymium glasses or stronger, if you have it. However, no equipment is necessary. We have a completely equipped shop and can supply whatever tools and eye protection you will need.

We will supply all the glass you will need for the workshop. Its cost is covered by the workshop tuition.

Wear clothing made of cotton or another non-melting fabric and closed-toe shoes. If you have long hair, you must be able to tie it back. Leather aprons or other substantial aprons are great if you have one, but they are not necessary.

We have a small kitchenette with a microwave and a refrigerator where you can store food. Also, water bottles, sodas and snacks are available at a modest price. Bring your lunch, if you can. Otherwise, there are several fast-food places nearby.
